COLOURING ACTIVITY



Each question will take you deeper. Stay in the shallow end or venture into deeper waters!

It is estimated that grown-ups make about 35,000 decisions EVERYDAY! Wow! most of those decisions these days are probably based around food! Have a chat about what kind of decisions you make everyday.

The decision that Zacchaeus made to become a tax collector meant that people did not like him. However, Jesus found it easy to like him and even wanted to be his friend. Why?

The crowd were not happy that Jesus wanted to be Zacchaeus' friend, they believe he did not deserve to be Jesus' friend. Have you ever made a bad choice which meant hurting those around you? How did they respond to you?

Because of the decision Jesus made to die on The Cross this now means we are forgiven for all the mistakes we make. All we need to do is say sorry. Jesus also helps us to say sorry to those we have hurt. JESUS IS OUR FRIEND, NO MATTER WHAT!



BIBLE VERSE

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and depend not on your own understanding. Proverbs 3 v 5&6

One way we can hurt others is by telling lies. Let's play a little game to see how good you are at hiding the truth. Find a small item of food like a marshmallow or grape (cut in half) — something that can be hidden in your hands or your mouth.

Maybe get a grown-up to play the game first — they need to go out of sight then hide the item of food either in their mouths or either hand. When they re-enter the remaining family members need to guess where the hidden item is... mouth, right hand or left hand.


